RE: School Reopening Update

Following the recent announcement from the Ministry of Education, we are pleased to inform you that our school will reopen on **Sunday, April 19th**. We Recognise that this news may bring both excitement and questions, and we are committed to keeping you fully informed as we move forward.

As many of our staff members will need to relocate back to Bahrain, and in order to implement the required health and safety measures, the reopening will almost certainly need to take place in phases. We kindly ask for your patience and understanding as we work to create a safe and welcoming environment for all pupils and staff.

The details of this phased return will become clearer once we know how many pupils are able to resume face-to-face learning. Your cooperation is essential in helping us plan effectively.

At this stage, the Ministry has indicated only two options: either the school remains fully online or transitions back to full face-to-face learning. Whilst a hybrid model has not been confirmed, we will use the parents intentions to inform our next steps. While we may be able to offer limited blended support for pupils returning to Bahrain, this option would not remain available once the school fully reopens, due to staffing commitments on campus.
