RE: Primary Update 14 April

I hope this message finds you and your family well.

Over the coming days, as a number of our teachers return to Bahrain, there may be some short-term adjustments to our online learning provision. We appreciate that changes to routines can be challenging, and we are grateful for the patience shown by our pupils and families during this transition.

Wherever possible, pupils will be able to join an alternative live lesson within their year group so they can continue to benefit from direct interaction with a teacher. However, due to staff travel at this time, this may not always be possible, and in these cases carefully prepared pre-recorded lessons will be provided to ensure learning continues. While this is not ideal, it is a temporary measure to support the safe and smooth return of our staff, and we kindly ask for your understanding and support during this period.

In addition, we would like to inform you that on Thursday, all pupils in Years 2 to 6 will follow a programme of pre-recorded lessons. This will allow our teaching staff to be in school to prepare classrooms and ensure that all emergency protocols and systems are fully in place before welcoming pupils back on Sunday 19th April. Pupils who have been attending in EYFS and Y1 will still have in-person learning.

As always, our priority is to ensure that learning continues in a structured and consistent way, while also making the necessary preparations to welcome pupils back safely.
