Following careful consideration, we have decided that there will be no formal end-of-year History assessment for Year 9 pupils this year. This decision has been made in the best interests of the year group, recognising that pupils have experienced an extended period without consistent subject teaching during the academic year. Grades for the end-of-year report in History will therefore be based on the previous assessment information already available.
